See the Burger Bar, where Hank Williams was last seen alive, visit the auditorium that June Carter and Johnny Cash called home, and see where the first "country" recordings were made in 1927. The ride takes you to Downtown Bristol, State Street where you can be in two states at once, plus Blackbird Bakery for the sweet tooth.
